Those .nvc-files & images for burning are parts of each folder.

Of course you'll have problems to open these if you've not downloaded the same NERO-7-programme. If you can open them then you could use these "images" and fill them up with your programme and the mpg-2 clips of the folder.

If you must burn the DVDs with other programmes you could use the same order of mpg-clips as given by the DVD/or CD-doc files on part-2

- **5 folders for four Allen-bio-disco parts and the Allen-Disco**

they include several ...doc-files from several chapters of the Allen-bio-discos = compilation of new-typewritten text & photos, adverts, label-scans. They include thousands of "signed"-text passages, if any visitor want to copy any text passages directly into the computer or stick. The jpg-photos are also back information for the used photos and use of "Microsoft-Photo Editor"

- possibly one folder for **jpg-DVD- / CD-photos** if necessary.

If you'll get the HARDDISC please make your own "HARD-DISC-Safety-Copy"
and be rather carefully . My suggestion for HardDisc-copies is to copy folder by folder (which needs longer time) but if you will copy it in one time it could be happen that you can copy one of the folders into another folder with later cross-relations on the file-background of the Harddisc.
